The Intrepid Fallen Heroes Fund (IFHF) is pleased to share that Nest Managers Real Estate team will spearhead a fundraising initiative to benefit the Intrepid Fallen Heroes Fund beginning in January 2021. A portion of management fees collected by Nest Managers Real Estate will be donated to the Intrepid Fallen Heroes Fund throughout the year.

The Intrepid Fallen Heroes Fund is a leader in supporting the men and women of the United States armed forces and their families. Established in 2000, IFHF has provided over \$200 million in support for the families of military personnel lost in service to our nation, and for severely wounded service members and their families. Today IFHF is leading efforts to help service members suffering the terrible effects of Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI). TBI afflicts hundreds of thousands of men and women who have selflessly served in defense of our nation. To help address this urgent need, the Intrepid Fallen Heroes Fund is building a series of 10 specially-designed treatment facilities, called Intrepid Spirit Centers, at military bases around the nation. Within these centers, service members receive the most advanced and proven care to address the complex symptoms of TBI, with the goal of returning these men and women to their duties in the armed forces. Eight Intrepid Spirit Centers are already open and serving America's brave service members, and the care provided has allowed more than 90% of patients to continue their service in the armed forces.

IFHF accepts donations from any individual or organization that wishes to donate but does not oversee or otherwise control the fundraising activities of organizations that raise funds to donate to IFHF and will not audit the fundraising from this event. IFHF will provide written acknowledgment to Nest Managers Real Estate upon receiving any and all donated funds.

All contributions to the Intrepid Fallen Heroes Fund are tax deductible to the fullest extent of the law. The Intrepid Fallen Heroes Fund is a non-profit organization and is a public charity exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
